During last year's AGM, Karoon Energy received a first strike on their renumeration report. Since then, it has listened to shareholders and factored their views into the remuneration outcomes for 2024, and the proposed remuneration structure for 2025. As a result, all the motions were carried at this year's AGM. The remuneration report received the highest number of votes in favour of any resolution (99.07%). The issue of performance rights to the CEO received 98.8% of the vote, and interestingly, the election of one director, Ms Luciana Rachid, received the highest number of votes against at 8.6%, as the company Samuel Terry Asset Management voted against this motion.
